2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 African Exploration Mining and Finance Corporation (SOC) Ltd ("AEMFC") is a state-owned Mining Company established to secure South Africa's energy supply primarily through the mining and supply of coal for the generation of electricity, as well as securing other resources that will provide energy for the future, including key minerals for beneficiation in the energy and steel value chain. As a growing company, AEMFC is currently operating an opencast coal mine (Vlakfontein Mine) established in 2011 which is located near Ogies in Mpumalanga Province, with its Head Office at Waterfall City in Johannesburg.
 - 2.2 AEMFC is a holder of Mining Right for Vlakfontein Mine which covers various portions of the farm Vlakfontein 569 JR. Phase 2 of the Vlakfontein Mine, known as the North Block is currently has been opened for mining. The North Block coal has been contracted to supply 2.5 Mtpa of coal to Eskom's Kusile PowerStation for duration of 4 years.
 - 2.3 The North Block reserve exploits both the No.2 seam and No.4 seam coal using opencast truck and shovel mining, which is blended to achieve contractual quality specification. However, the No.4 seam used for blending is limited to small portion of this mining block and runs out within 2 years of life of mine. The remaining No.2 seam alone has high ash content as a result of in-seam parting and cannot meet contractual quality specification without being blended or destoned or beneficiated.
 - 2.4 The No. 4 Coal Seam is divided into No. 4 Upper and 4 Lower Coal Seams. The No. 4 Lower Coal Seam in mining block covering the bunker is the only seam that has been extensively mined, by underground mining method. The underground mine out areas were used as bunkers for storage of crude oil. Most of the oil was pumped out of the bunkers but there is still residual oil remaining in the bunkers. Currently, water is periodically pumped out of the mined-out areas to limit the impact to the environment. The No.4- upper coal seam is still intact so as the No.2 and No.5 coal seam (present in some areas).
 - 2.5 Approximately 68.5% of the remaining coal resources in Vlakfontein North Block are attributed to the No.2 Seam, which also contains some of the best quality coal. The seam averages 5.8 m in thickness and varies in Ash content from 25% to 48% with average of about 37% .
 - 2.6 The mine is facing coal qualities challenge with the current reserve that is being mined. A concept study was commissioned to look into coal beneficiation, and coal beneficiation plant was recommended.
 - 2.7 Subsequently, AEMFC conducted opportunity framing exercise where a number of strategic options were identified for assessment.
- 2.2 Thus, the Service Provider is requested to provide a proposal based on the scope of work (Section 5 - SOW).
